

Nova Scotia Community College is pleased to announce 26 Entrance Awards to recognize outstanding students coming directly to NSCC from Nova Scotian high schools.

**Who can apply?** Any Nova Scotia high school graduate coming to the College directly from a provincial high school in September of 2006 is eligible.

Students who have completed high school, or who expect to complete high school between December 2005 and June 2006 are eligible to apply.

Applicants must have been offered admission to a full-time program and have paid the required College confirmation fee.

**Value?** The awards, in an amount equivalent to first-year tuition for a Certificate or Diploma (\$2,500 in '05-'06), will be honored as a credit toward tuition.

Half of the award will be applied to the student's account in each of the first two semesters. Students must successfully complete all courses in the first semester to be eligible for the second semester tuition allocation.

Sons and daughters of NSCC Employees are eligible to apply for the award, pro-rated, based on the current tuition waiver policy.

**Criteria?** Awards will be made based on a minimum average of 75% of the top five Grade XI marks and up to five of the top Grade XII marks. A recent official transcript in a sealed envelope must accompany the award application.

Applicants are required to submit a brief essay on the merits of a community college education. The maximum length should be no more than 500 words or two pages of double-spaced, typed text.

Consideration will also be given to financial need. Applicants should include a short statement indicating how they plan to fund their education.

**How to apply?** Applicants are required to complete an application form (please see reverse).

Each application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, high school teacher, or principal. This letter should comment on the applicant's merits and community involvement, as well as general suitability for the award. If applicable, the letter should include a statement confirming the applicant's financial need.

**Deadline?** Please submit your application to the NSCC Campus where your attendance is confirmed. The deadline for receipt of applications and all supporting documentation is **May 19, 2006**.

While the application material will remain confidential, successful recipients must agree to have their name announced by NSCC in the media.
